Hotel and Travel Considerations:

A block of rooms has been arranged for conference participants at the Morongo Casino Resort and Spa, located at the foot of the beautiful San Geronio and San Jacinto Mountains on the Morongo Indian Reservation. Morongo 's 27-story landmark hotel tower has 310 beautifully appointed deluxe rooms, including 32 suites and six oasis casitas. The hotel has been rated ☆☆☆☆ by AAA for the past three years. Guests can choose two queen-sized beds or a king in any room. Smoking and non-smoking rooms are available.

Room rates for the Conference are \$99 per night for Wednesday and Thursday midweek nights and \$139 for Friday (weekend rate). Taxes and resort fees will be applied. Driving Directions

Morongo Casino, Resort & Spa is located just off I-10 in Cabazon, approximately 20 minutes west of Palm Springs.

From the west, exit on Apache Trail. Turn left (north) at the exit. Turn right (east) on Seminole Drive. Follow the signs to the valet/porte cochere entry.

From the east, exit at the Cabazon (Main Street) exit. Turn right (north) at the exit. Turn left (west) on Seminole Drive. Follow the signs to the valet/porte cochere entry.

Airports Nearby

Morongo Casino, Resort & Spa is within driving distance of Palm Springs, Ontario and Los Angeles International airports. However, the closest airport is Palm Springs.
